Worship in the Scottish Episcopal Church varies by region, diocese, church, individual practice and custom. There is no right or wrong way to worship and we encourage visitors to relate to God in their own way. St John's worships in a relaxed and friendly atmosphere but with spiritual reverence.

Our custom at St John's is to stand for the Gospel, Gloria, Creed, Hymns and Communion and to sit/kneel for prayers, sermon and readings. Words in **BOLD TYPE** are for the congregation to recite together.

Services start at 11am and usually last one hour.

Liturgies: Blue books when we have a priest and White books for Reserved Sacrament. All are available in LARGE print.

Hymns are projected.
